

What is Time2 Activ8?

Time2 Activ8 is a free, 7 week course for people between the ages of 18 - 25 who are unemployed and need help to plan their future. The course involves two/three afternoon sessions per week.

What is it about?

Participants will learn skills that will help them to find a job or to source the education or training they need to pursue their ideal career. There is also help for people who are looking at starting their own business.

There are separate sessions on financial supports and how to access job schemes or courses and also on CV and interview preparation.

One to One Support

Participants will receive one to one help to look at their options and plan their next step.

Who is it for?

The course is funded by the Department of Social Protection so all participants must be receiving a social welfare payment.

Where and when is it starting?

The course will be starting on Wednesday, 26th March and will run for 7 weeks in Carrigaline Parish Centre.

How can I find out more?

There will be a taster event in Carrigaline Parish Centre on Tuesday, 11th March where you will have the opportunity to meet the tutors and find out more about the course.
